University Assistant (f/m)

(fixed-term employment for the period of 4 years, 40 hours/week (Uni-KV: B1)

at the Faculty for Technical Sciences, **Department of Applied Informatics**, Research Group **Information Systems**. The monthly minimum salary for this position as stated in the collective agreement and according to the classification scheme is € 2.794,60 (pre-tax, 14 x per year), but may be higher due to previous employment periods eligible for inclusion and other earnings and remunerations. The beginning of the four-year fixed-term employment contract is **as soon as possible**.

Your duties:

- Scientific research (under the supervision of Prof. Jannach) with the goal to obtain a doctorate degree
- Participation in research projects
- Teaching and supervision of students
- Involvement in administration
- Participation in public relations activities of the department and faculty

In research and teaching, the research group **Information Systems** works on the application of intelligent systems to practical operational problems. The research group focuses in particular on the design and evaluation of recommendation systems, the application of data mining methods in the business environment and personalized software services in general. The spectrum of the research activities ranges from the application of new methods of artificial intelligence to research into the effects of such information systems on their users. The Department of Applied Informatics is very well networked internationally in science and industry.

Your profile:

- Completed relevant master's or diploma studies at a university in Austria or abroad
- Fluent knowledge of German and English in spoken and written form or willingness to acquire them within the first year of employment

Desirable qualifications are:

- Excellent or good academic success
- Relevant international and practical work experience
- Social and communicative competences and ability to work in a team
- Experience with university teaching and research activities
