M.A. Curriculum – Programme Structure

- **Required Subject: 18 ECTS**
 - Defining essential questions of a subject areas
 - Developing individual research question
 - Knowledge of suitable methods of analysis
- **Electives: 48 ECTS**
 - Critically explaining and applying selected methods in areas of linguistics OR English-speaking cultures and literatures
 - Placing these concepts in the larger context of linguistics OR Anglophone cultural and literary studies

M.A. Curriculum – Programme Structure

- **Master's Thesis: 30 ECTS**
 - Must comprise 30,000+/- words (main text)
 - Not connected to a specific course
 - Can be started in the first semester (find a topic, find a supervisor)
 - Account for deadlines (grading, exam, submission, etc) near graduation
- **Optional Subjects: 12 ECTS**
 - Can be chosen freely from the courses offered by recognised domestic and foreign universities

M.A. Curriculum – Programme Structure

- **Comprehensive Examination: 12 ECTS**
 - Covers two subject areas from the specialisation
 - One relates to the master's thesis and also contains further questions
 - The other can be freely chosen (within the specialisation)
